

Under Pressure Training

FREE - ½ day online workshop facilitated by Stirling Women's Aid

This workshop aims to support professionals working with young people to open discussions with them about some of the challenges and pressures they may be facing including: risks of grooming and sexual exploitation, negotiating online safety, engaging in healthy consent-based relationships, and dealing with the pressures to conform to idealised models of 'how to be' men and women.

The target audience is for those who support children and young people. The training is designed to increase knowledge and understanding of:

- the effects of gender stereotyping on young people
- the signs and effects of abuse within young people's intimate relationships
- increased confidence in talking with young people about the issues of relationship abuse and exploitation
- using the socio-ecological model
